Why RESPRO was created: NCLB requires states to provide technical assistance to districts and schools not making Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for **two or more consecutive years**. So, Illinois



created ten RESPROs that have provided services to the districts and school in status for the last two years. Districts and schools are provided assistance needed to meet the rigorous standards of NCLB. The RESPRO system gives district and schools the help they need to create high achieving learning environments for all students statewide.

Steps for Accessing Support for Status Schools:

1. Contact ROE Professional Development Staff
2. Staff will complete or have you complete a request form
3. Staff turns form(s) into Program Coordinator
4. Activity is approved and money is earmarked for the activity
5. Agendas and attendance sheets are completed and turned in with the bill
