Purpose:

Reading Is Fundamental Program (RIF) is a joint effort between the Regional Office of Education, the national RIF and our individual school districts to encourage literacy through access to books and motivational activities. RIF is funded by federal and regional funds for students in Kindergarten and First Grade.



Description:

The Regional Coordinator for RIF, Marsha Conley, will work closely with the school coordinators to have successful book distributions throughout the school year. School coordinators are encouraged to contact the ROE with any question or problem they may encounter.

Starting this year much of the RIF information will be provided directly to the school coordinators through email contact. Each school will be contacted for the name and email address of their RIF coordinator at the beginning of the school year.



The coordinators receive information about

- when their book distributions should be held
- when they should receive their books from the supplier
- how many books they will receive
- when their distribution reports are due.
