What is the Standards Aligned Classroom Initiative?

The Standards-Aligned Classroom Project provides training and support for teachers to align their classroom-level lessons/units and assessments to the Illinois Learning Standards. Participants will learn to:

- Select, modify or create lesson plans and/or units of instruction that align with the Standards
- Select, modify or create appropriate classroom level assessments to assess the Standards
- Evaluate students work to determine if students have met the Standards
- Launch school-level “Learning Teams” for ongoing reflection and stud on aligning classroom instruction and assessments with the Standards

What is the school based team?

A school-based team is comprised of one building-level administrator and a minimum of three teachers and a maximum of five teachers. All SAC Teams must be comprised of volunteers willing to sign a participation agreement.

What are the requirements for the SAC team?

Members of the Standards Aligned Classroom team agree to the following:

- Attendance at a two (2)-day Learning Team training
- Participation in the team meetings over the year
 - Team must complete “Unit Plan Organizer”
