Digital Age Learning, Illinois' K-12 state technology plan, provides focus for the LTC delivered activities. LTCs work in cooperation with the Regional Offices of Education and Intermediate Service Centers, higher education, special education, and vocational education partners and the Illinois business community.

There are 15 Learning Technology Centers statewide.

Summary of LTCs' work in K-12 schools:
